

## The Epilogue

Members of the audience are asked to join in making the chorus sounds in the Epilogue.

The women performers will be in the aisles and speaking to small groups in the audience.

The women will be speaking phonemes from the repeated phrase, "she was a visitor."

The women performers will choose the phonemes randomly.

Each phoneme will be sounded for one full breath.

An audience member can simply follow a woman performer's choice of phoneme and speak that phoneme for one full breath. In other words, echo the sound the woman performer near you makes. Do this at an ordinary voice level or softer.

There are twelve phonemes as spelled out below.
